- Wartime Veteran or Surviving Spouse
- Served at least 90 days of continuous active duty service during eligible dates
- Honorable Discharge or equivalent
- In need of assistance with care
- Income/Asset Requirements

VETERANS AID AND ATTENDANCE PENSION

WHAT IS IT

The Veterans Aid and Attendance Pension is a benefit designed to improve the quality of life of our aging veterans and their spouses by providing financial aid for the expenses associated with assisted living and/or care needs.

It is a non-taxable, monetary benefit that is paid monthly to Veterans, Veterans and Spouses or Surviving Spouses who are in need of assistance with the physical tasks and care needs associated with daily living.

Those eligible for this Pension can use the funds to help finance the cost of care at an assisted living facility or at home. The following is a summary of the monthly monetary benefit:

- Individual Veterans can receive up to \$1,644 per month*
- Veterans and Spouses can receive up to \$1,949 per month*
- Surviving Spouses can receive up to \$1,057 per month*

WHY AM I NOT RECEIVING THIS BENEFIT

This valuable benefit often goes unclaimed because people are not aware of its existence, do not think that they are eligible to receive it, and/or are discouraged from applying for it once they are presented with its complex and bureaucratic application and eligibility process.
